Bellevue Farm West

I81: Exit 255 West onto Rt. 262, Go 8 mil, or Exit 220 West onto Rt. 262 N, Go 4.3 mi. to Rt 254 West (Parkerburg Turnpike) Exit. Follow west 7 mi. to Buffalo Gap. Just west of the Rt. 42 Junction Convenience Store, TL onto Rt. 703 (Hewitt Rd.) go 0.3 mi, TR @ fork onto Rt. 705 (Scott Christian Lane), cross RR, follow curve L past a large house and little woods to the gate on L, TL through the gate to hayfield parking.

Bolen

(from the south) From Interstate 81, take Exit 180 (one of two Natureal Bridge exits) and go south on Route 11 (Lee Highway). At the bottom of the hill, turn right on Herring Hall Road (Route 686). After 0.7 miles, turn right on Padgetts Hill Road (Route 690). At the stop sign, turn right on Plank Road (Route 610). Proceed approximately 4 miles. After the sharp S turn, turn in at the open gate between the two barns and park in that pasture.

(from the north) Take interstate 81 South to Exit 181 for Route 60 West. Take Route 60 West toward Lexington. Turn left onto Route 11 South. At the next traffic light continue straight onto Route 251. This will become Collierstown and Lake Roberson. Route 11 will turn – stay straight onto Route 251. This will become Collierstown Road. Immediately after the Moose Lodge on the left, turn left onto Possum Hollow Road. You'll go around a blind curve and the road forks. Take the right fork onto Plank Road. Go about a half mile. At the intersection with Zollmans Mill Road (Route 753), follow Plank Road to the left along the creek. Bolen's is another mile further down Plank Road. Drive across the Kenneth Moore Memorial Bridge over Buffalo Creek. Park in the field on the right. The gate between the two barns will be open.

Take Rt.460 (from east or west) to stoplight at Rt 24. Turn south which is to the right if coming from the west or left if coming from the east. Go through the small town of Concord. Turn left around new traffic circle on Spring Mill Rd. Go about 5 miles and turn right on New Chapel Rd. So to the next road, Plum Branch, and turn right. Go a short distance and take the first driveway on the left (not to brick house but farm drive after it). There is a VERY small wooden sign that says The Meadows at Naked Creek. (Yes, the grandson spelled it wrong when he made the sign). Stay on farm lane until you go through farm gate into cowfield. We park at the top of field.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, there will be no tailgate. However, riders are encouraged to bring their own food.

As a reminder, current negative Coggins, hunting license and signed waivers are required for all meets.
